### **Summary**

The first working group represented the continuation of the event that was organised on 12/09/2015. In the discussion, the representatives of the 5 municipalities shared their expectations and experiences with the public procurement process. Furthermore, Mr. Jovica Georgievski, Skopje advised participants about the correct method of preparation of technical tender documentation.

### **Objectives & main programme points**

At the beginning of the event, attendees were introduced to the project objectives and expected results and also were presented the successfully implemented EPC projects in Austria, as part of this project. Afterwards the project partners presented the questions that were planned to be discussed. The main discussion between the attendees was about the amount of maintenance cost for the streetlight.

### **Conclusions & lessons learnt (based on stakeholder input)**

The goal of the event was to discuss about the questions that were appointed as relevant on the September by the municipal representatives. The conclusion was that municipalities have lack of qualified personnel for the public procurements, the final decision is on much higher level, and the current Law for public procedures is not allowing signing EPC.
